Many thanks for applying to present a paper at the International Conference for Experiential Learning. This letter is to formally accept your proposals and invite you to register as a delegate.

The proposal accepted is:

Paper- *“Transformando la cultura organizativa: Por un Liceo que aprende”*

If you are seeking funding it may be useful for you to know that your paper has undergone the following refereeing process:

1. Reception of papers
2. Removal of names and references that make the papers identifiable
3. Numbering of papers
4. Distribution of papers to review panel (members of AIEP Professional Institute of the Andres Bello University and 2 members of ICEL organising team)
5. Feedback collected in meeting and/or by email from review panel
6. Rejection or acceptance sent to applicant depending on the outcome of the feedback. Where a majority opinion has not been reached modifications are sought.

The rejection rate to date has been 15% for papers and 5% have been asked to modify and re submit.

After the conference a selection of papers will be published in electronically in PDF Conference Proceedings format. This selection will be made during the conference according to feedback from peers, organisers and ICEL committee.

So that we can best represent your paper or workshop in the conference handbook and that your paper is well attended, please send us a description of fifty to seventy-five words that accurately reflects and ‘sells’ the paper or workshop to other delegates.

To present at the conference you must be registered as a delegate and have paid the conference fee of \$650 dollars (Latin America price). Many thanks if
